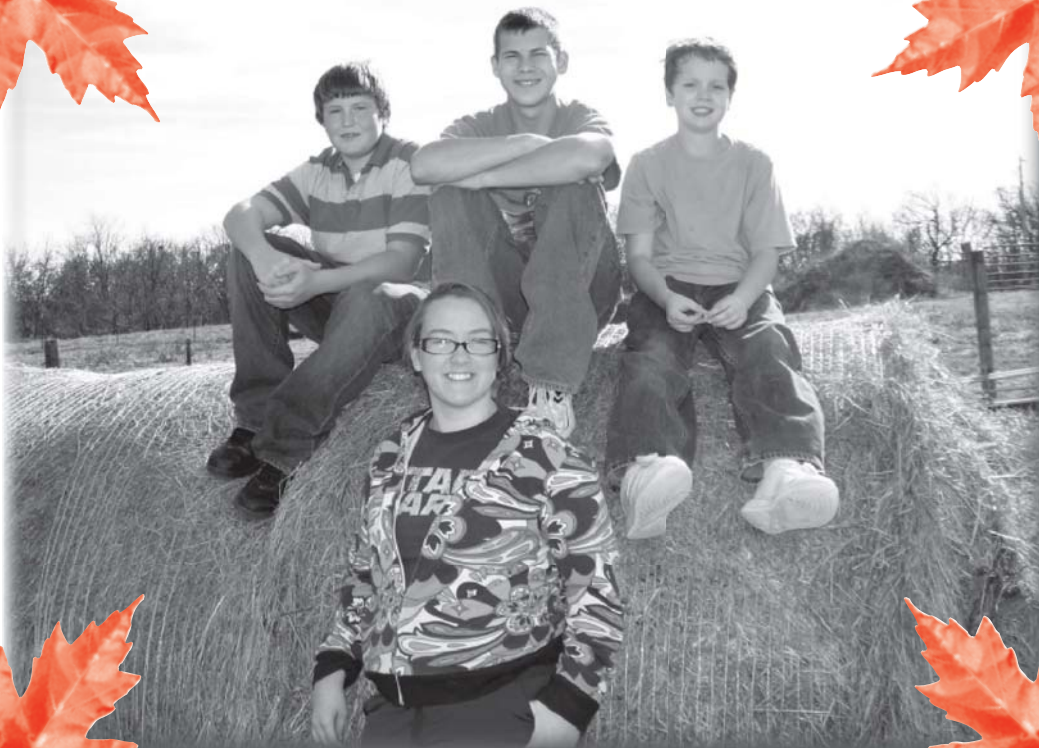

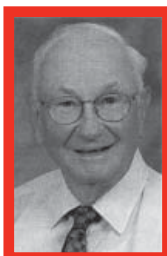
wish to give in memory of Nattalie send their memorial gifts to Show-Me Christian Youth Home.

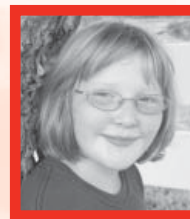

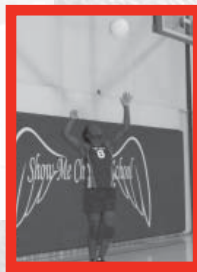
The Show-Me Angels Play Volleyball
