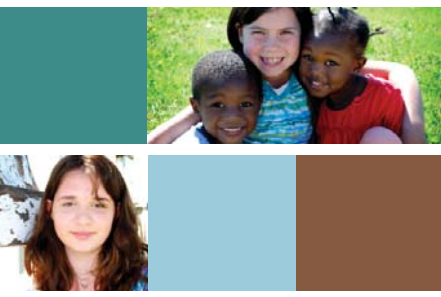

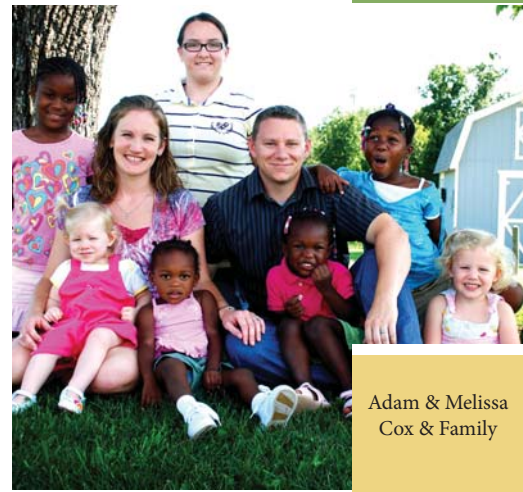


Welcome Home

THREE FAMILIES JOIN THE SHOW-ME TEAM TO CARE FOR CHILDREN ON A FULL-TIME BASIS.

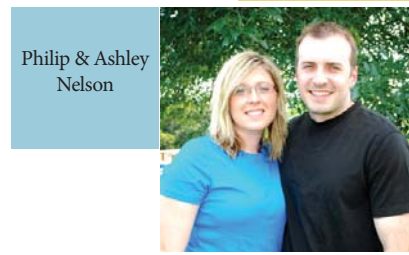

TRADITIONS: Bringing Families Together

MAKING MEMORIES AS A SHOW-ME FAMILY

Making a family out of many children from very different backgrounds can prove to be a challenge. But we feel it is one of the reasons our program is successful. Traditions give the children something they will have in common now and in the future. So even when children have different biological parents and backgrounds, the experiences they have here can bring them together and traditions can bring common ground to their lives. Each Show-Me family has traditions of their own and there are traditions that the Show-Me family as a whole share.

THANKSGIVING: Because many of our children spend Thanksgiving with their biological families, we celebrate Thanksgiving the Saturday before the holiday. We all gather together in our Multi-Purpose building and share a kernel of corn before our meal to remind us of the times when that was all Pilgrims and Native Americans had and they still gave thanks.

CHRISTMAS: We celebrate Christmas Eve December 21st. Our families go caroling in

their communities and deliver plates of home-baked goodies. They return home to have their Christmas Eve dinner, read the

A Journey Home

A STORY ABOUT GROWING UP AT SHOW-ME CHRISTIAN YOUTH HOME.

One bright, spring day several years ago, a young teen took her first glimpse of Show-Me Christian Youth Home. She saw the nice homes and the structure, met caring staff and other students, and decided quite firmly, “I don’t want anything to do with this.”

There’s something about the familiar that’s comforting, regardless of how dysfunctional it truly is.

A family history of substance abuse and mental illness set her up for an early life of hurt and fear; by adolescence she learned to disguise those feelings with drugs and alcohol and other risky behaviors. Family members tried to intervene, even the Juvenile Office, but the slippery slope continued. That family structure within which God designed us to thrive kept slipping further away. She didn’t trust anyone; she didn’t have anyone to trust.

Willingly, though without enthusiasm or alternatives, she gave Show-Me a chance. She moved in, set up her room, and started “playing family” but kept everyone an arms-length away. She longed for her old friends, her own rules and her former “normal.” Just as she was beginning to be “okay” with this program, tragedy struck. Her father’s suicide launched her into

unbelievable pain and chaos and a desperate need to once-and-for-all have something stable.

While dealing with this tragedy, things started to clarify for her: she began to miss her “new family” and her “new home.” She recalls, “I realized then that my new parents really did love me.” Ah, the stability she’d always longed for now realized.

In reflection, she comments, “God put me there, right there with you guys. He knew who I needed.”

“The family vacations, the guidance, even the structure that I hated, made me feel like I really was one of your own children. And, I found out I could finally be myself.”

When she reflects on what life would have been like if her path hadn’t lead her through Show-Me, she’s sure she would have ended up dead. With the family history, self-destructive tendencies, and evaluation of where her former friends are now, she’s probably correct.

But she’s very much alive!

Solid marriage, two adorable children, active in church, and half-way through nursing school -- the life she never dreamed possible.

Of course, she didn’t have to: we saw it in her the first time we met her!

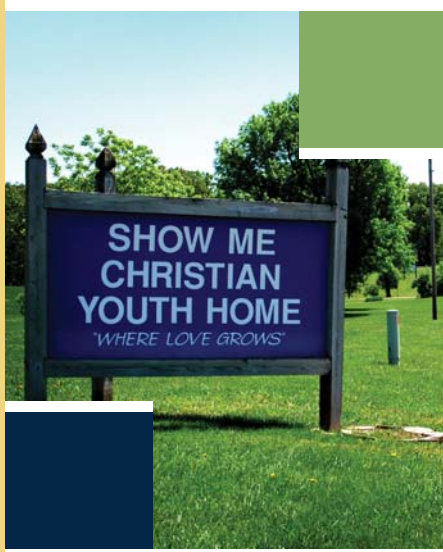
